## Tax Filing Deadline Dates

We expect a real busy tax season. If you want your work to be filed timely, you need to get your materials out to us as soon as possible. Remember, if you are a corporation or business you may need to **issue 1099s or W2s by January 31** as well as **file any quarterly payroll work.** You also need to get your **partnership/corporate returns completed by March 15.** Personal returns are due April 15. Have mercy on us and get your materials in to us early.

## Other thoughts about 2007 Taxes!

**Please read all material I enclose in my mailings.** I have some new operational guidelines for some of my clients (like the need for engagement letters in some cases) and thus request cooperation in the application of these new procedures

**There are no significant changes in tax law this year that will affect the majority of my clients.** Some things always change like rate tables or exemption and standard deduction amounts, for example the mileage rate for business use of vehicles is now 48.5 cents per mile. We can discuss any of these changes with you upon the preparation of your return.

**The IRS is cracking down on many issues and is placing more onus on the Tax preparer to be the enforcer.** Unrealistic tax positions by a tax client cannot be supported by this office. Please bear that in mind when presenting your tax information for our review. We will do all we can to keep your tax bill at its lowest but must insist that the returns that we prepare can sustain a reasonableness review.
